The 2006 show also marks Provence Promotion’s third far from commonplace participation considering the regional participants working together with the association on the stand.

Therefore, the Provence-Alpes-Côte d’Azur region and Corsica CCIs, working in partnership with the Region and the Ademe, have decided to organize their presence around a collective stand so as to promote all their environmental skills and know how. About 500 companies in the PACA region have a principal or secondary activity in this field. Note that one of the major technological clusters in the region, the Arbois Europole, is dedicated to the environment and will also attend the show with the major “Capenergies” and “Management of risks and vulnerability of territories” competitiveness centers.
