





Business parks around South Marseille

The business parks around South Marseille enjoy a privileged work environment close to the sea and the Calanques National Park. In an urban environment on the beautiful Prado artery, in the renovated old industrial quarters or right next to The Calanques, there are many different places to live between the sea and hills, little old villages and new residential districts.

The Prado quarter with its beautiful buildings is an excellent option just a few stops on the metro from the city center. The historical business quarter, it includes the Velodrome stadium, the Cité Radieuse building (a famous architectural work by Le Corbusier) and the museum of contemporary art. A few stops away by bus, the quarters of Mazargues, Roy d'Espagne, and Sainte-Anne and Saint-Giniez have

a village feel. A village in the city, a stone's throw from the sea and the Calanques National Park. A good compromise for city people who love nature.




DO YOU PREFER TO LIVE BY THE SEA?

An exceptional landscape, featuring white expanses of rocky inlets and the inky black of the vertiginous Cap Canaille cliff, Cassis offers a privileged living environment. A village built into the hillside, this little fishing port has retained its ancient charm with its colorful facades and a culture oriented towards the sweet life. It will enchant sea lovers with its little coves and crystal waters.

Further inland from **Cassis**, in the heart of the hills, **Carnoux** is a good option for smaller budgets, 15 minutes from the sea.

ARSEILLE?



On the A55 freeway and through the Prado tunnel. Using the bus network and changing onto line 2 of the metro (Rond-Point du Prado). From April to September a sea shuttle runs between Pointe Rouge and Vieux-Port, a lovely way to reach the city center.

Medical Services

The second-largest health hub in France, the hospitals of Marseille (3,400 beds) are in close proximity and are among the best healthcare providers in the country. In Marseille, the service is organised around 4 regional hospitals (CHRs) and is completed by world-class private healthcare establishments such as the Hôpital Européen, opened in 2013.

The southern districts include excellent public health facilities such as the Hôpital Sainte Marguerite and the Hôpital Saint-Joseph as well as private facilities like the Clinique Clairval. Finally, by 2018 the new Velodrome guarter will have a modern outpatient clinic with a small short-term inpatient unit (24 beds).

Sports

Rock climbing or hiking in the Calanques, jogging along the seafront or in Parc Borély, sailing or diving at the Pointe Rouge, kite surfing or windsurfing on the beaches of Prado... the range of outdoor activities is huge! At Borély Racecourse, you'll find a compact 9-hole golf course, while Parc Pastré is home to an equestrian center open to all types of riders aged 4 and up! Finally, Bonneveine swimming pool is equipped with a large lap pool, provides aquarobics classes and welcomes infant swimmers.

Shopping

Lovers of window-shopping will be spoiled for choice with the many shops in the center of Marseille, the Bonneveine open-air shopping mall with a hypermarket and 60 stores, in addition to the La Valentine mall. Finally, in 2017 a 23,000 m2 shopping mall in the new Velodrome quarter will open its doors, which will include a department store, a supermarket and convenience stores.


