Carpooling is promoted through the www.tousecomobiles.org site for the employees of these business parks. Soon there will be the Val'Tram, an inter-city tram that will connect Bouilladisse to Aubagne.

Medical Services

Aubagne has two hospitals: La Casamance private hospital and Edmond-Garcin medical centre, which offer high-quality technical infrastructure and a full range of treatment regimens. The Charrel Medical Services Centre is open seven days a week from 9 am to 10 pm, rounding out the care options.

Gémenos has built a municipal sports complex with a pool, tennis court, basketball court and running track. If you are into football, the Marseille Foot Indoor in La Valentine is for you! Eight pitches spread over 7000 sq. metres are reserved for football, a sport that runs in the veins of Marseille natives! Swimmers can get in their laps at the Chartrel pool in Aubagne, made famous for being the site where Olympic champion Alain Bernard trained.

In Aubagne, the bustling centre of the Paluds business park boasts cafés and restaurants and the Auchan shopping centre has many options for people looking to grab a bite. Gémenos also has a large range of dining options to choose from with over 40 restaurants. Employees at Domaine Vallée Verte can head over to the Valentine shopping centre when they are feeling peckish.
