Nicknamed the "little Versailles of the South", **Aix-en-Provence** is one of the loveliest cities to live in, with its pedestrian center ideally suited for strolling between fountains and terraces. It is a university city with almost 40,000 students studying at the law and humanities colleges, the political studies institute (IEP), the teacher training college, and the national school of Arts and Crafts. Aix-en-Provence hosts internationally acclaimed festivals of music and dance, and has some beautiful performance venues including the 'Pavillon Noir' and the 'Grand Théâtre de Provence'.

With direct highway access to your work, the villages of **Brignoles** and **Saint-Maximin-la-Sainte-Baume** charm, with their location at the foot of the Sainte-Baume mountain range, equidistant from the first Alpine foo-thills and the sea. Whilst being socially and culturally dynamic, each of these towns boasts a charming ancient center with well-preserved architectural heritage.

To the southeast of Aix, with the Sainte-Victoire mountain immortalized so many times by Cézanne as a backdrop, those who love pretty Provençal villages will set down their suitcases in **Châteauneuf-le-Rouge** or **Fuveau**. These villages perch in their surroundings, with steep little streets, wash houses and fountains, and they are well located between Aix and Marseille, served by the highway and just 15 minutes from your work. Both vibrant villages, Châteauneuf-le-Rouge hosts the Provençale food festival, whilst Fuveau is home to a renowned literary festival.

F, GARDANNE AND MEYREUIL?



It's 30 minutes to the Marseille-Provence international airport, 20 minutes to the TGV station at Aix-en-Provence, and there's direct access to highways A51 and A8, which get you to Aixen-Provence in 10 minutes and Marseille in 20 minutes. The Cartreize public transport network ensures that the areas are well connected.

Medical Services

The Rousset, Gardanne and Meyreuil business parks are located between the **hospitals of Aix-en-Provence** and Marseille (3400 beds), comprising France's second healthcare hub. At Aix-en-Provence there is the 780-bed public Pays d'Aix hospital complex, a 200-bed multidisciplinary private clinic, and a private general hospital renowned for its surgical unit. Marseille offers four regional general hospitals (CHR) operated by the Marseille Hospitals Welfare Service (APHM), and this is complimented by high-level private healthcare establishments such as the European hospital, which was opened in 2013. Brignoles has a general hospital with 256 beds, of which one is a maternity bed.

Sports

Fitness circuits, horse riding centers, 18-hole golf in the Aix countryside, hikes on foot or mountain bike rides around Sainte-Victoire, there's no shortage of outdoor activities. As well as fitness centers and sports clubs, you will find swimming pools at Aix and Fuveau (brand new!), and in summer at Brignoles and Saint-Maximin-la-Sainte-Baume.

Not forgetting that in less than an hour you can be at the sea, with its range of exhilarating watersports (kite surfing, sailing, diving...).

Lunch near your workplace

At the Gardanne, Rousset and Meyreuil business parks there is a bakery so you can eat on the go, caterers who deliver to the office, pizza trucks and a restaurant offering daily specials. You can also have lunch nearby in the town centers of Gardanne, Meyreuil and Rousset.

Shopping

At the heart of Aix-en-Provence you'll find the 'Provençal Lanes', a very pleasant open-air shopping venue of a manageable size, which brings together more than 50 stores, some of them big international brands. Food, leisure equipment, household goods, clothes... To be sure to find absolutely everything, head 20km from Aix to 'Plan de Campagne', the biggest shopping center in France with over 400 stores. And the icing on the cake is that it's open on Sundays!

Did you know?

Every summer since 1948 the Aix-en-Provence Lyric Art Festival has taken place. This is an internationally recognized festival of opera and classical music. In June and July, high-flying artists take up residence in some beautiful spaces, such as the 'Jeu de Paume' Theatre with its Italian room dating back to the 18th century, the 'Grand Théâtre de Provence' with its wonderful acoustics, and the new Darius Milhaud 'Conservatoire de Musique' designed by Japanese architect Kenzo Kuma.
